



Graduate Program in Health Sciences Faculty Position

Twenty years ago, a strategic institutional decision of focusing on research quality rather than quantity resulted in a small number of young and vibrant graduate programs and a scientific production that ranks among the best of the country in research impact and number of citations. As a consequence, over the past years, PUCPR has been regularly positioned among the top Brazilian and Latin American institutions in research excellence by independent international rankings such as the Times Higher Education, QS and Scimago.

About PUCPR

Established in 1959, PUCPR (www.pucpr.br) is a private, non-profit catholic university based in Curitiba, the capital city of the state of Paraná, Brazil. At PUCPR, more than 27,000 students are enrolled in one of the 60 undergraduate, 28 graduate and more than 150 extension programs. Graduate training – masters and PhD – is available in the areas of **health sciences**, animal sciences, law, urban management, philosophy, theology, business management, mechanical engineering, dentistry, production engineering, education, computer sciences, health technology, bioethics, cooperative management and human rights.

POSITION

This is an opportunity for a single, full-time, research-oriented position at PUCPR Graduate Program in Health Sciences (PPGCS, in Portuguese). Distribution of activities will be 20% teaching and 80% research. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: teaching undergraduate and graduate courses; recruiting and advising graduate and undergraduate students; posting and maintaining regular office hours; serving on faculty committees as assigned or elected; participating in professional development and scholarship activities; attending regularly scheduled faculty department and other institutional meetings; applying for funding opportunities (public and private); publishing relevant work in high quality scientific journals.

ELIGIBILITY – Candidates must:

- I- Hold a doctorate degree in Health Sciences, Medicine or related areas that qualifies the candidate to supervise and/or conduct investigations in Health Sciences with focus on translational research;
- II- Present relevant and regular scientific production as defined by Brazilian agency CAPES for the area of Medicine I, notably in Qualis A1, A2 and B1, or equivalent international criteria, as first or last author;
- III- Lead or be part of research teams in studies in your area of expertise and of relevance for the Public Health Care System;
- IV- Prove previous experience as lecturer at undergraduate and graduate programs;
- V- Have excellent written communication skills;
- VI- Have team working capacity;
- VII - Prove supervising skills of undergraduate and graduate research projects;
- VIII- Collaborate in national and international research groups;
- IX- Be proficient in English;
- X- Check scientific production with translational and health innovation characteristics.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Candidates should submit (i) a statement of research and teaching interests along with a detailed *curriculum vitae*; (ii) a work plan for the next 4 years within the context of the eligibility criteria; (iii) a letter containing minimum identifying information of the candidate: name, passport (if applicable), degrees, degree institutions, address, telephone number and contact e-mail.

Documents may be submitted either in English or Portuguese to ppgcs@pucpr.br with the subject “Professor Position/Vaga para Professor”.

Selected applicants will be invited for an interview and to give a lecture in their field of expertise. This opportunity is open to foreigners, Brazilians and PUCPR faculty. In the case of a draw, PUCPR faculty will have priority. Foreign candidates may be interviewed and give their lecture by videoconference.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

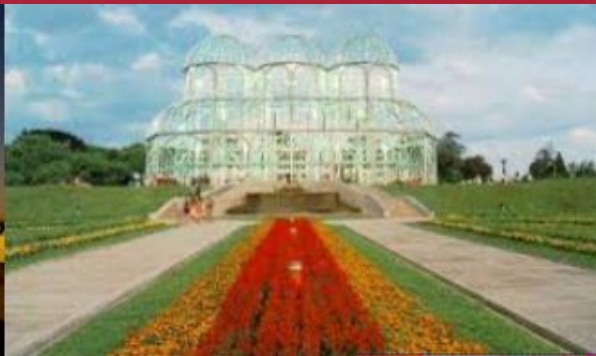
